Motobeemer.com 2024 Moto Tour Key Points

- Free to all Participants* / Limited to 15 slots*
- 5 Day Tour (24 June 2024 to 28 June) Arrive 23 June.
- Colorado loop, with 1 day in Moab, Utah
- From 200 to 400 (+) miles per day
- Plenty of planned picture, video opportunities
- All Paved roads planned, but an opportunity for dirt
- Potential for rain, hail, extremely cold temps exist in June in Colorado. Good tires, gear, change of gear is critical for this trip
- Road worthy motorcycle capable of maintaining sustained speeds on State Routes and Interstates is necessary
- Riders will be required to sign a Hold Harmless Agreement between them and Motobeemer LLC

*A \$200 refundable deposit will be required to hold a slot and establish a commitment to attendance, once 15 slots are reserved a waiting list will be created.



Free Tour: What's the Catch?

- Free for the initial launch of Motobeemer's Tour Program, subsequent tours will have a cost
- Participants will be responsible for bringing or renting their own Motorcycle, sourcing their own gear, ensuring their bikes have the appropriate tires, luggage capacity and more
- Participants will book their own hotels, be responsible for their own meals and beverages
- Participants will provide an Emergency Contact just in case, also if a breakdown occurs, we will assist as much as we can (on site, minor repairs) but primary plan should be to call a local tow company and your personal insurance to assist and go from there

Day 1 Details (June 24)

Primary Route
Estes Park and RMNP

Alternate Route
Idaho Springs to Granby

Weather Late June could force RMNP to close Trail Ridge Road, hence possible Alt Route

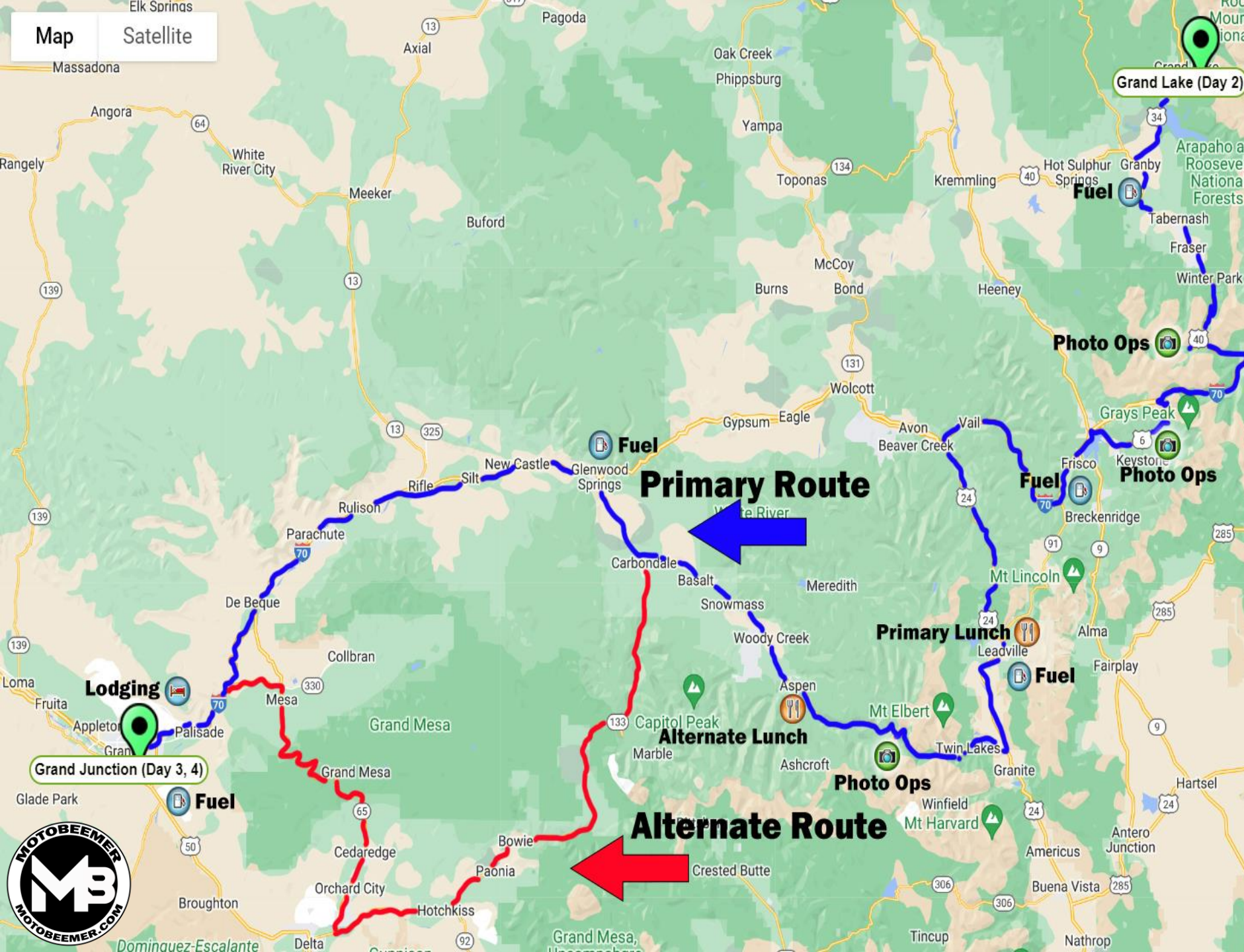
Fuel Stop in Estes Park will be enough for the day

Lunch in Estes Park, plenty of Photo Opportunities in Estes and while through RMNP, even in Granby

Prepare for a cost to enter RMNP, \$25 cashless payments

Be prepared for potentially cold temps in RMNP (30 F or less)





Day 2 Details (June 25)

Primary Route
Leadville and Aspen to GJ

Alternate Route
Carbondale to Delta to GJ

Glenwood Canyon often experiences mud slides which could force use of Alt Route

Fuel Stop in Frisco and Glenwood Springs if necessary

Lunch in Leadville, lots of Photo Opportunities throughout the ride at multiple Mtn Passes

Be prepared for potentially cold temps at the top of Loveland and Independence Pass (30 F)

This is a longer mileage day, efficiency will be critical C



Day 3 Details (June 26)

Primary Route
CO Nat'l Monument, Cisco to Moab, Naturita to GJ

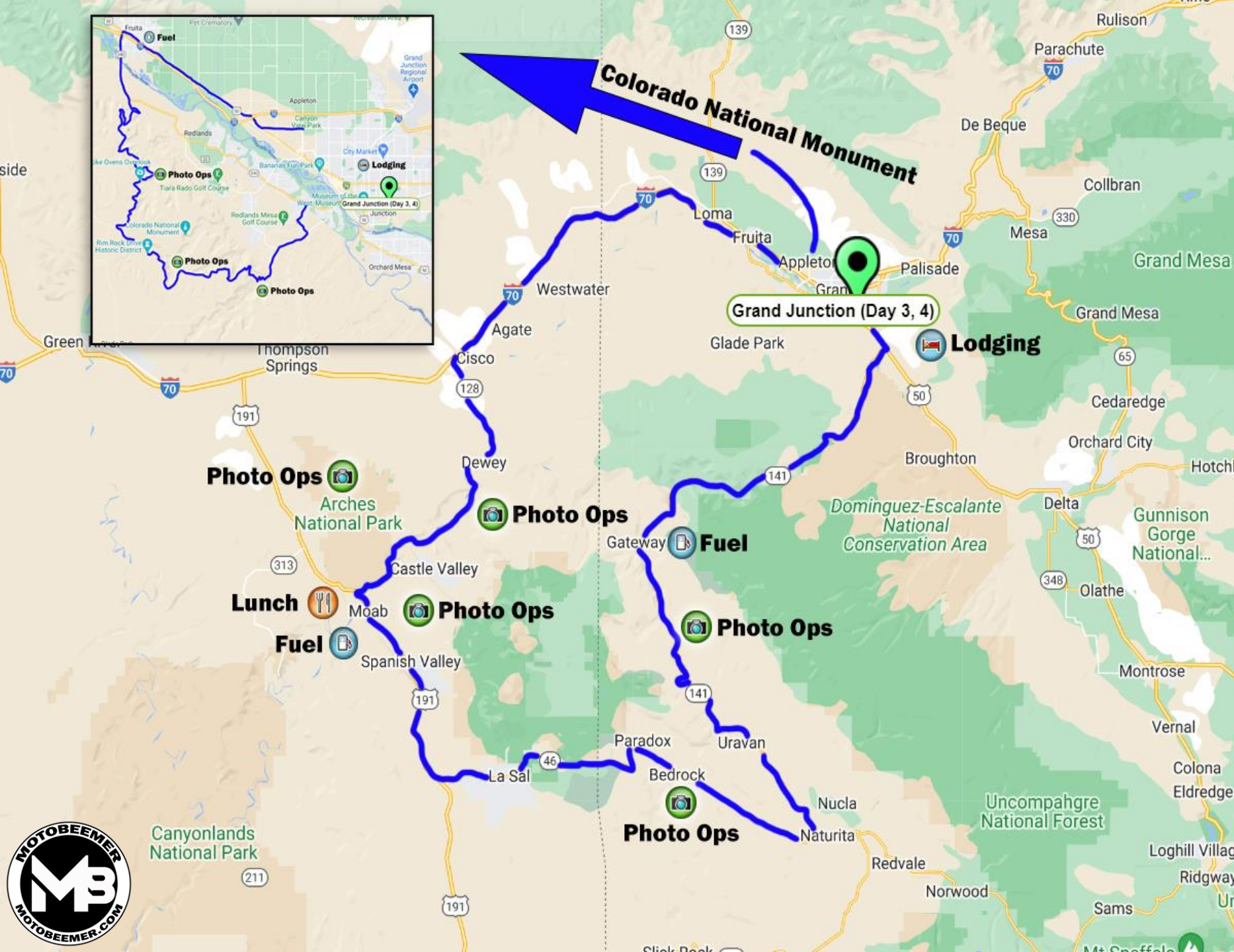
Alternate Route
TBD but should not be needed

Fuel Stops in Moab and Gateway Canyons

Lunch in Moab, plenty of Photo Opportunities at CNM as well as Arches, Moab, Gateway Canyons

Prepare for a cost to enter Arches, and CO Nat'l Monument \$25 Cashless Payment

Potential for high winds on this route, also long stretches with no place to purchase drinks or snacks



Day 4 Details (June 27)

Primary Route

Delta, Ouray, Silverton to Durango

Alternate Route

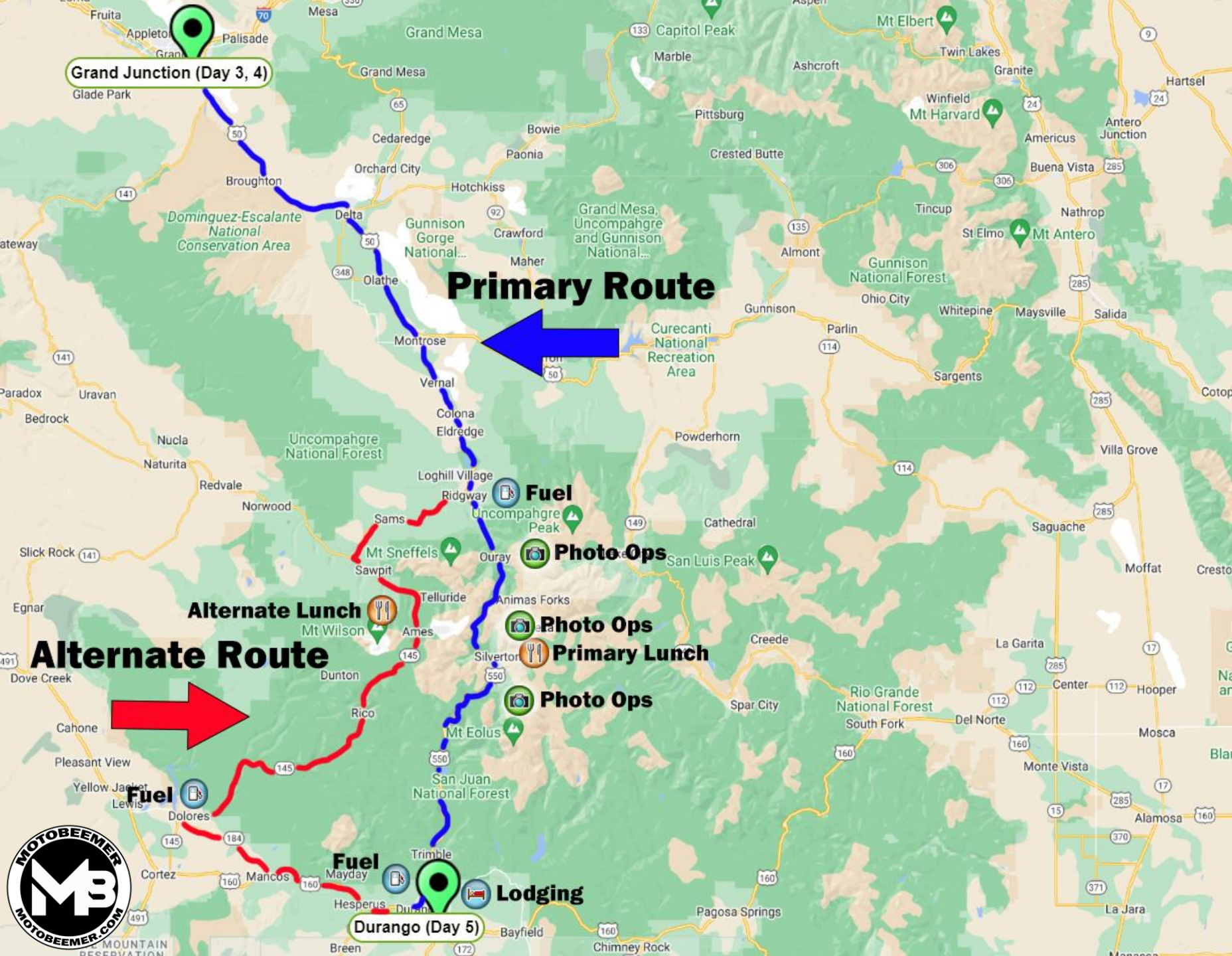
Ridgway, Dolores to Durango

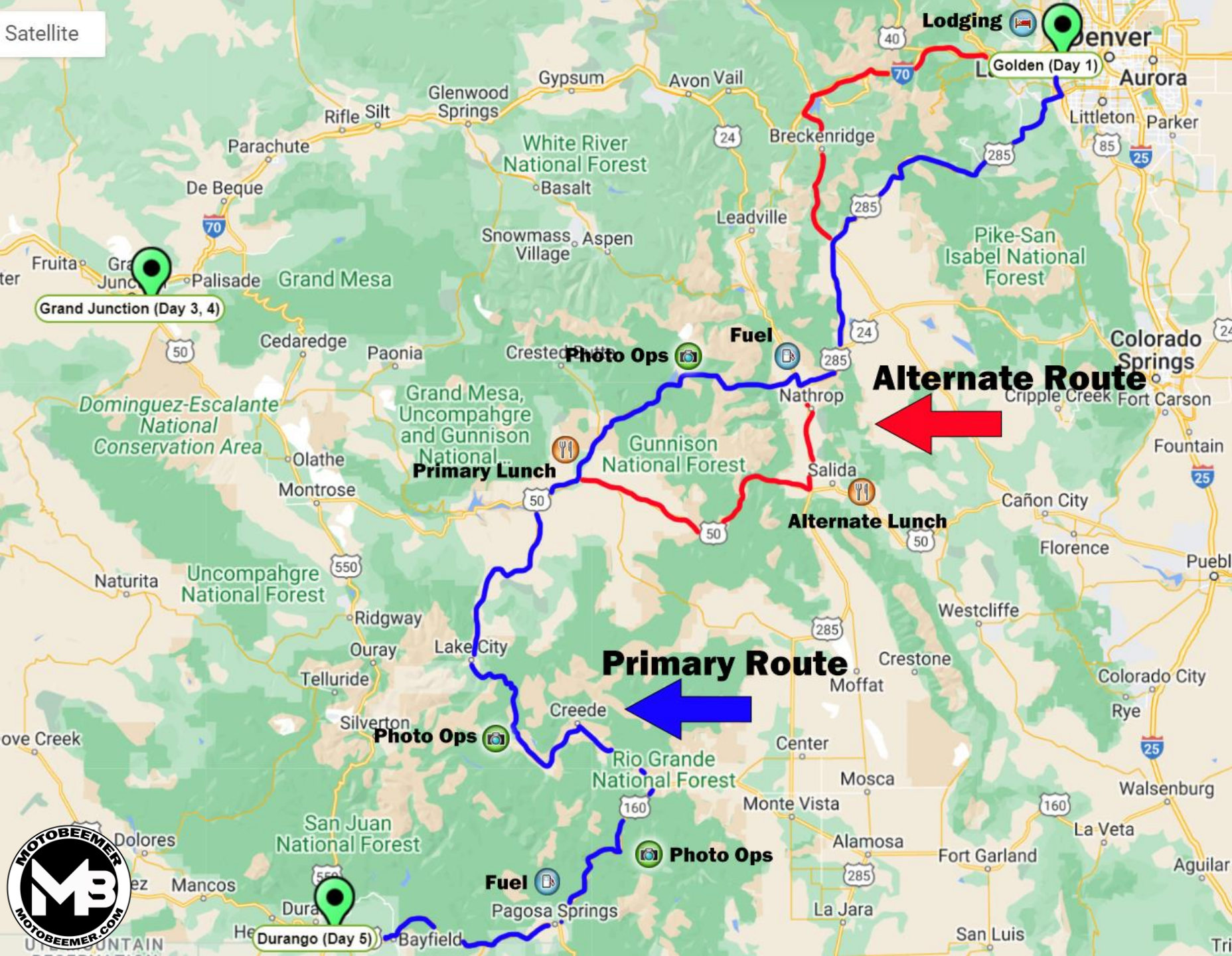
Million Dollar Highway could have an accident on it or closed for weather, hence Alt Route

Fuel Stop in Ridgway will be sufficient for day

Lunch in Silverton, plenty of Photo Opportunities in Ouray, \$\$ Highway, Silverton, San Juan National Forest and more

Potential for colder temperatures crossing into Silverton, have extra layers and gloves just in case

Salida to Breck and I-70

Cottonwood Pass closure could
force use of Alt Route

Fuel Stops in Pagosa Springs and
Buena Vista

Lunch in Gunnison, plenty of
Photo Opportunities over Wolf
Creek Pass, Slumgullion Pass,
Cottonwood Pass and more

Prepare for cooler temps over
high mountain passes, extra
layers and gloves potentially

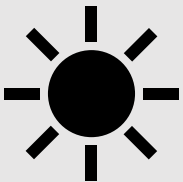

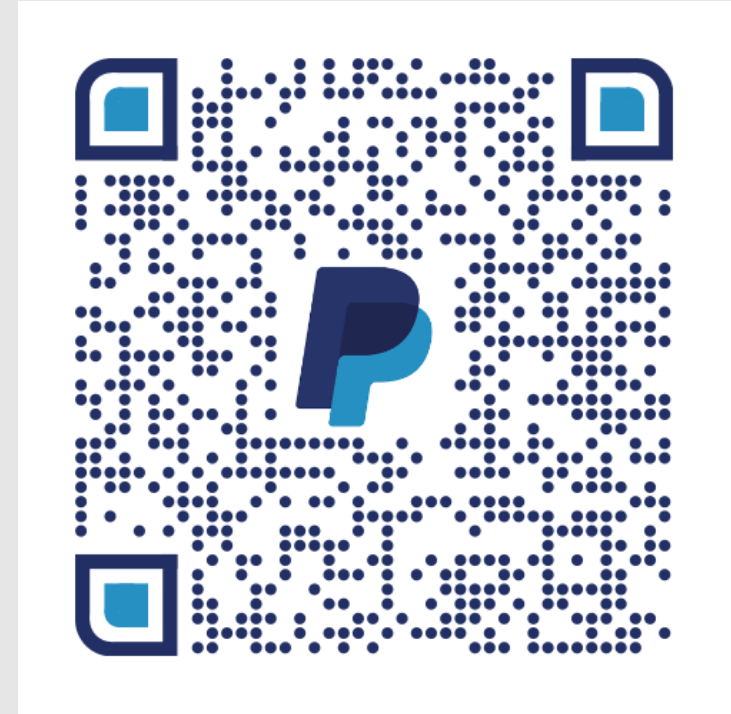
